

### What in the world is Missions Camp?

Missions Camp is a great opportunity for students to learn how to do missions through hands on experiences. They get to meet North American and International Missionaries. They learn to grow spiritually and are challenged to make Jesus as their personal savior if they haven't already done so. They have Bible study, missions education, swimming, recreation and other fun activities. Plus they get to have a great time meeting other students from across the state.

### Who can attend Missions Camp?

Missions Camp is for all students that will have completed the 3rd—12th grade by the time of camp. It is for both boys and girls.

### What do they do at Missions Camp?

There are four groups at Missions Camp. Those in 6th and 8th grades have the choice of staying in the younger groups or advancing to the older groups.

Girls in Action (GA Camp) is for the girls 3rd-6th grade. This group stays on campus for their mission projects, has recreation, swimming, singing, meets missionaries, creates crafts and lots of other fun filled things.

Royal Ambassadors (RA Camp) is for the boys 3rd-6th grade. This group will also stay on campus for their mission projects, has recreation, swimming, singing, meets missionaries and possibly goes hiking, fishing, does woodworking and lots of other fun-filled things.

RA's and GA's are together for some recreation time and worship.

Servant Evangelism (SE Camp) is for both boys and girls 6th-8th grade. This group leaves the campus for mission projects. One of their main projects is to host Block Parties in neighborhoods. They also do servant style evangelism projects such as car washes or hospital ministry. Students are challenged to share their testimony and learn to lead others to Christ and be his witness by showing a servant attitude.

Fun Explosion (FE Camp) is for both boys and girls 8th-12th grade. This group also leaves the campus for mission projects. They host multiple Backyard Bible Clubs in various types of settings. They may support these projects with the use of puppet ministries or sports clinics.

Both SE and FE participants will be given the opportunity to join in the clowning ministry which supports both FE and SE but then stay with their age appropriate groups for other functions. The two groups are together for some recreation and worship times.

All groups will eat together and worship together at the Friday closing celebration.

### Directions to Parchment Valley:

**From Charleston:** Take I-77 north to Ripley, Exit 138, bearing into the left turn lane on the exit ramp. At the traffic light, turn left onto State Route 62 South.

**From Parkersburg:** Take I-77 south to Ripley, Exit 138, bearing into the left turn lane on the ramp. Turn left and proceed to the traffic light, bearing into the right turn lane. At the traffic light, turn right onto State Route 62 South.

Travel approximately 0.6 mile (landmarks are the American Electric Power facility on the left and a veterinary clinic ON the right.) At the first intersection, the WV State Police office will be on the right and Parchment Valley Road (big, blue sign) will be on the left. Turn onto Parchment Valley Road and travel for 2 miles.

**Do not use Google or Mapquest—you will get lost! If using GPS, use 1715 Lower Parchment Valley Road as the physical address.**
